Lanna Baptist Church;

Thank God for Pastor Apisit who is doing a great job of leading that congregation. They have opened the church for a homework club outreach. They help teach kids English, Math, Science, and Computers and Bible for every classes on Saturday. There have been 70 students that signed up for tutoring. Then on Sunday these students come to Sunday school and worship with us. I still visit the church and preach there once a month. I have also continued to help with the special projects, like their Christmas party. We had a special service on December 23rd, and over 100 students and parents came. Four adults and eight children came to the Lord that day.

Wieng Ping Baptist Church;

On December 16th, we had a special baptismal service for nine people, and seven of them were from Samuel School. We also had a Christmas party and over 70 people came. We had two people come to Christ. In January a science teacher got save her name is Goy. Goy went to a Christian school when she was younger, and she was taught to believe in God but never about what it meant to become a believer. She ran into an old friend who invited her to church here, and now she has started coming to church and learning what Christian life looks like.



In December, we went the small village that many of our kids at Samuel School are from. We held a special Christmas service, and three people were saved there. Two of the people were father of our kids. One of them his name is Park, he told us that his wife and daughter had been praying for him for years, and God finally answered that prayer!

Praise the Lord for the land that God gave us for Samuel School. We have now paid all the \$203,000 off. The title of the land is now in our hands. We are so thankful for all of you who have joined us in our ministry, and every day God affirms that He has called us here. Now that we've paid off the land, our next project is a school building for Samuel School. We've been doing classes in the church building, but we hope to grow. We also will need more teachers to teach more students, so we hope you'll be praying about all of these needs. The seven students in this first group are great kids. They have a lot of growing, and they have their teenager moments but God has brought them here and He is doing great things in their lives and they are experiencing a new life in Christ. Please remember them in your prayers. We hope they will be leaders and ministers in their communities.
